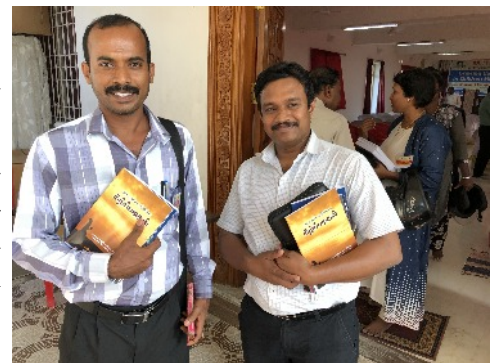
Helping Children's Workers in India

One of the greatest challenges to Gospel ministry is that of reaching the more than 500 million children of India. The numbers are vast and the diverse languages and cultures present real obstacles in providing an effective ministry. We are very thankful to have opportunity to have a small part to play in ongoing gospel outreach to children in India. CEF has many workers all over the country doing a great work. Such workers need resources to enable them to teach Biblical truths. Help is provided to them and many others through our partnership with INDIA BIBLE LITERATURE based in Chennai. For some years we have been working with this indigenous mission to have many of our publications translated and published in various languages.



Recently 5 new titles have been translated and published in Tamil, Telugu and English. These books help give more understanding of the work to be done in reaching children with the gospel. The books help the reader to understand the 'Principles of Teaching' and gain insight in how to teach the doctrine of 'Justification' Additional help in a book called 'Smooth Sailing' shows how good it is for workers to serve God with humility and good personal

relationships. Other books provide encouragement for what is often a difficult task 'Obedience to the Heavenly Vision' and 'Problems of a Children's Worker and God's Solution' These books were distributed in a series of one day conferences taught by Terry & Wilma Flannigan in the cities of Chennai, Velore and Vijayawada. early in 2020. The theme of the conferences was 'Going Deeper in Children's Ministry' In each location large numbers attended and many expressed appreciation for the help given. The past number of months have seen new publications being translated and printed in Poland, Serbia, Nepal and Myanmar. Our contacts in each country have worked hard to provide help to many hundreds in their own language. The publications include visualised doctrine lessons which put tools into the hands of those teaching Bible truths to children in these needy lands.



We have also supplied CEF Philippines with 3,000 sets of visual lessons for use in their schools outreach. These were printed with the help of Revival Movement Association here in N Ireland.

We have a new agreement with RMA to print and distribute many of the visualized doctrine lessons in various languages including Spanish and French. This will enable many to engage in more in depth teaching of Bible truths.

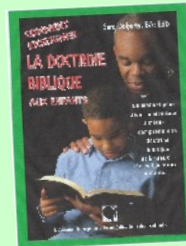

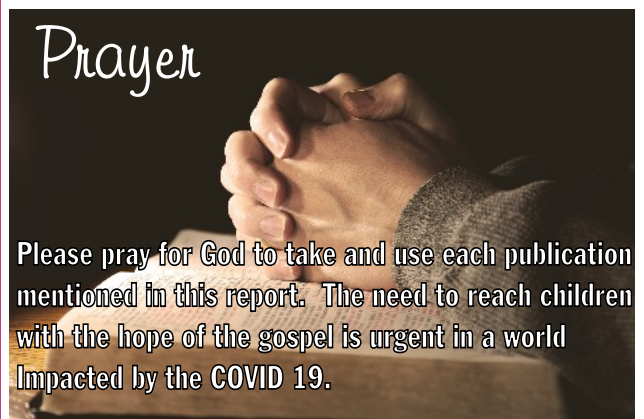
Tu parles Français ?
